1984

The CFD was The Executive **Ethics Board** created through an **Executive Order** from Governor part of state John Spellman with the assistance of its volunteers to Thurston County Auditor Sam Reed. resources to run

2000

2003

The CFD becomes official state law through the passage of RCW 41.04.033

2004

The CFD creates one of the first online giving platform for public employees in the country.

2010

The CFD moves from the Department of Personnel to the Office of the Secretary of State.





EXECUTIVE SPONSORS

This leader is chosen by your agency director. They help you gain support from executive management.

Duties may include:

- Sending e-mails of support
- Assisting in volunteer recruiting efforts
- Acting as a liaison with management
- Communicating with front-line supervisors



CAMPAIGN LEADERS

Act as the agency-wide CFD lead by recruiting, logging fundraisers and providing support to Local Coordinators.

Duties may include:

- Recruiting Local Coordinators
- Logging fundraisers
- Ordering CFD supplies
- Building a theme (agencywide or CFD's theme)
- Communicate with Local Coordinators





LOCAL COORDINATORS
